
Whereas the 2<sup>nd</sup> party can use the first party's play ground at any time for the needs of the institution subject to prior intimation.








**Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Assam**, being the beneficiary of this MoU having its campus in PO- Belsor, Dist- Nalbari, Assam 781304.

## Whereas

ICT Academy is an initiative of the Government of India in collaboration with the state Governments and Industries. ICT Academy is a not-for-profit society, the first of its kind pioneer venture under the Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) model that endeavors to train the higher education teachers and students thereby exercises on developing the next generation teachers and industry ready students.

ICT Academy was started to meet the skill requirements of the industry and generate more employment especially in tier 2 and 3 towns, the rural parts of the country. The organization was formed with representations from the State Governments, leading companies in the ICT industry and National Association of Software Services Companies (NASSCOM) in India.

With training of teachers and students as the primary objective, ICT Academy has been working through a seven pillar program in the areas of Faculty Development, Student Skill Development, Entrepreneurship Development, Youth Empowerment, Industry- Institute Interaction, Digital Empowerment and Research & Publications.

ICT Academy has approached SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM to be the institutional member of ICT Academy to offer various courses to the teachers of the college.

ICT Academy is also keen on collaborating with SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM and is agreeable to enter into this MOU with SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM as per the terms and conditions set out hereafter,

**Now this MOU witnesses as under**

### **1. Scope of the MOU**

- 1.1. SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM hereby agrees to become the institutional member of ICT Academy to offer its services to the teachers/researchers in SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM
- 1.2. ICT Academy agrees to provide the following services to the teachers/researchers of SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM.
  - 1.2.1. ICT Academy shall provide Industry relevant Training Programs in the domain of ICT, for the Teachers / Research scholars
  - 1.2.2. ICT Academy shall provide industry relevant training programs for the students, at a nominal cost mutually agreed by both the parties
  - 1.2.3. ICT Academy shall make its content accessible through a web portal for the teachers/researchers of the institutions
  - 1.2.4. ICT Academy shall conduct guest lectures, seminars, workshop and conferences for the teachers and the students in association with university and its colleges
  - 1.2.5. ICT Academy would provide assistance in Research activities to the teachers by way of supervision and collaboration
  - 1.2.6. ICT Academy shall invite the teachers/researchers to submit research papers for publishing in ICTACT Journals
  - 1.2.7. ICT Academy shall invite for research proposals for funding, which shall be applied for joint funding from research funding bodies.
- 1.3. SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, shall notify about the program of ICT Academy to its departments and assist in the active participation of the teachers.
- 1.4. SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, shall provide the following infrastructure at its campus for some of the training programs, workshops and conferences to be conducted by ICT Academy.
  - 1.4.1. Computer Lab infrastructure (Hardware, software and peripherals)
  - 1.4.2. Training room for conducting the training programs
  - 1.4.3. Conference Hall /seminar Hall/Auditorium
  - 1.4.4. LCD projector and screen.
- 1.5. The teachers/researchers of SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, would attend some special training programs at ICT Academy Campus, Chennai (If interested). ICT Academy shall provide necessary infrastructure for the conductance of the training program.
- 1.6. SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM hereby undertakes that it shall not utilize the

Contents, training materials and such other information provided hereunder beyond the scope of this MOU and shall not share such information with any third party or render services utilizing the materials, contents, training materials to the third parties without the consent of ICT Academy except for academic activities.

- 1.7. ICT Academy agrees to provide various domain specific training program to the teachers in the university and its colleges on regular basis.
- 1.8. ICT Academy shall bring industry certified trainers of the SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, on every program conducted for the teachers/researchers of the college.
- 1.9. Both the parties shall explore and jointly develop new course for the teachers from time to time the terms for the same will be discussed as and when required
- 1.10. Both the parties shall explore to work on specific ICT related research areas as per the industry requirement and agreed upon by both the parties

## 2. Operation of this MOU

Upon execution of this MOU, ICT Academy shall communicate to SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, the training schedules. Thereupon, the parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms based on which ICT Academy would offer its various other services.

## 3. Validity of this MOU

The validity of this MOU would be for One year from the date of the signing. The MOU may be renewed through a new MOU on completion of three year on such terms mutually agreed between the parties. Both parties shall have the right to terminate this MOU if any of the party does not comply with its obligations under this MOU by issuing 30 days prior notice

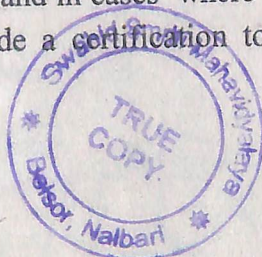
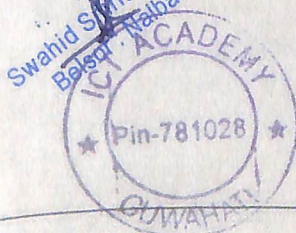
## 4. Confidentiality

4.1 The parties shall treat all information, documents, contents and materials that are specifically declared as confidential pertaining to ICT Academy or SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, provided under this MOU as confidential.

4.2 ICT Academy or SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, shall not disclose any aspect of any confidential information to any third party in any manner whatsoever other than in the normal course of agreed terms under this MOU.

4.3 The confidentiality of information shall survive until the termination of this Agreement.

5. Upon the termination of this MOU, SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, shall return all the contents, training materials and such other information provided by ICT Academy under this MOU duly without any undue delay and in cases where such information is not capable of being returned, destroy the same and provide a certification to that to ICT Academy.



## 6. Intellectual Property

All the intellectual Property rights with respect to the programs contents provided by ICT Academy shall vest with ICT Academy and upon the termination of this agreement by efflux of time or such other earlier termination, SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, shall not have the right to use programs, contents, and such other training materials installed under this MOU and return the same to ICT Academy.

## 7. Notices

All notices regarding this agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail postage prepaid or by courier, at the address as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner. Any such notices shall be deemed received when actually delivered if personal delivery or three days after delivered to an overnight or express mail facility, if delivered through post.

## 8. Governing Law

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the law of the republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Guwahati/Chennai.

## 9. Commercials

It is a Non Commercial MoU between ICT Academy and SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM. The College will provide the infrastructure and space to host the Faculty Development Programs at their premises.

## 10. Arbitration

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between the parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this agreement either party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT Academy, the other to be appointed by SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA, ASSAM, and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties.

The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Guwahati/Chennai.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) BETWEEN  
THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY

FOR**

**Collaboration in the field of Research, Training, Student and Faculty Exchange etc.**

**1. Preamble:**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day, 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2023, between **THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY**, a state private University, established by The Assam Royal Global University Act 2013 (to be read with The Assam Private Universities Act 2007), notified by the Government of Assam Gazette on 23/8/2013, herein after referred to as "**FIRST PARTY/RGU**", having its campus at Betkuchi, NH-37, Guwahati-781035, Assam. Starting its first academic session in July 2017, RGU currently offers multiple courses in diversified fields.

And

**SWAHID SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA**, herein after referred to as "**SECOND PARTY/Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya**", has a campus on approximately 2 acres of land in Nalbari district of Assam. It is an arts college with six departments. The college has research facilities with a DBT sponsored collaborative research project. is affiliated with Gauhati University, P.O- Belsor, Pin- 781304, Dist- Nalbari.

**The Assam Royal Global University, Guwahati and Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya** are hereinafter collectively referred to as 'the Parties/Universities/Institutions' and individually as 'the Party/University/Institution'.

**2. Purpose:**

That the broad objective of this agreement is to have a common platform for Research / Faculty and Student Exchange Program/ Summer & Winter Internship/ Projects/ Joint Consultancy/ Joint Training Programs/ Effective implementation of NEP 2020 also considering issues related to NAAC, NIRF and UGC notifications on UTSAH and PoP etc. and other activities as agreed upon by both the parties.

**3. Statement of Mutual Benefits & Interests:**

3.1 Together, these two parties shall work towards furthering cooperation in both education, training & academic research which will be mutually beneficial for both institutions.

3.2 Parties shall work in cooperation for research activities; joint training programs; exchange of faculty members; summer programs; student exchange; joint publications & sharing of information, etc. in addition to taking advantage of RGU's multi-disciplinary, inter-disciplinary, vocational degree thus, providing benefit to the students of the college under the NEP 2020 scenario.

#### 4. Forms of Cooperation:

The Parties envisage the following cooperation within the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):

##### 4.1: Exchange of Faculty members

For planning and handling of academic programs and courses, organization of seminars, workshops and conferences including the exchange of mutual experiences in teaching, research, and industrial practices with prior approval from parent institutions. Honorarium, transportation, and accommodation/hospitality as per institution norms.

##### 4.2: Exchange in Research

Through joint programs in research and development, including provision of Summer/Winter Internship Programme for the students of RGU and vice versa. During the period, either institution will provide hostel accommodation to the visiting students as per the institution norms. Prior approval and agreement of the head of the concerned department of the institutions is to be obtained to allow students to work in laboratories for projects, internships, etc. The Vice-Chancellor/Registrar/Principals of the universities/institutions will be the sole authority to grant final approval.

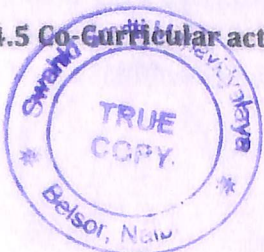
##### 4.3: Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects

RGU faculty will involve some of the selected faculties of Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya (depending upon their interest and expertise in a chosen domain) to be Co-investigators in their project proposals for funding and vice versa. Faculty members involved in any such projects will need to seek prior approval from respective Heads of the Institution.

##### 4.4: Seminars / Symposia / Workshop/ Training Programs to be jointly organized

To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs, to organize seminars, conferences, training programs or workshops on topics of mutual interest, and invite faculty members from both the institutions to participate therein. However, for specific co-operation, projects shall be negotiated separately between the Parties and, in each specific case, shall be established as separate written agreements, stating the respective rights and obligations of the Parties.

##### 4.5 Co-Curricular activities (Sports, culture, debate, quiz etc.)

RGU and Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya may conduct some Inter-University joint events, joint camps, training for specific sports etc. with mutual consultation.

**5. Financial Obligations:**

There will be no financial obligations on both the parties under this agreement.

**6. General Coordinators:**

Each party shall designate an administrative office/ department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU.

**7. Intellectual Property Rights:**

RGU and Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, all rights linked to ideas, inventions and patents generated during the MoU shall remain the common intellectual property of the Parties. The Parties shall not pass on or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.

**8. Dispute Settlement:**

In the event of any dispute or difference arising under this Agreement, the Parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the Parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed pursuant to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The Parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the Parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

**9. Liability:**

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

**10. Force Majeure:**

Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to eventualities like floods, earthquakes, strikes, bandhs, lockouts, epidemics, riots and commotions, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation or cessation of such events, the party affected thereby shall give notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond four months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

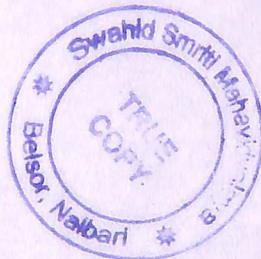

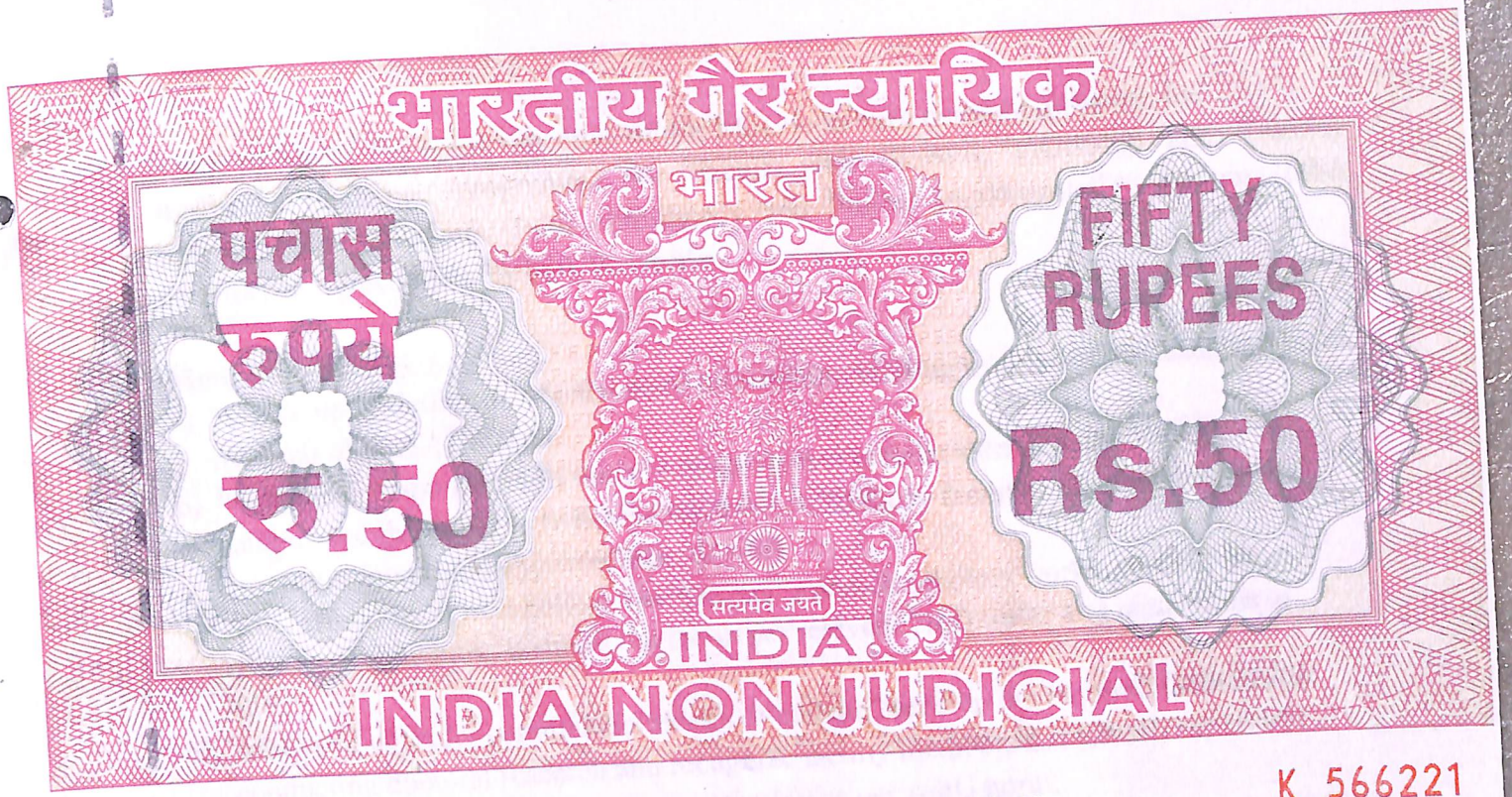

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 2023 by and between Assam down town University, herein after called "AdtU", having its official address at Sankar Madhab Path, Gandhi Nagar, Panikhaiti, Guwahati, Assam, India PIN-781026. WHEREAS Assam downtown University was established through the Assam down town University Act, 2010 by Down Town Charity Trust established a multi-disciplinary university in the year 2010. Assam down town University is located at Panikhaiti, Kamrup (M) in the Assam state capital region, 12 km away from Dispur. Assam down town University (AdtU) is approved by UGC (University Grants Commission), the Government of Assam, AICTE, and AIU (Which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject shall mean and include its successor-in-office and permitted assignees) of the "FIRST PARTY".

Swahid Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Belsor, Assam, India Pin- 781304, The college is permanently affiliated to Gauhati University and is under the purview of Section 2(F) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956. It is provincialized under Govt. of Assam having its own campus at Belsor, Nalbari. It is approximately 14km away from the district head quarter of Nalbari District, hereinafter called "SECOND PARTY".

1. **Scope of MoU:** The broad objective of this MoU is to have common platform for Research, Exchange programme for Faculty and Student, Internship and Training programme for students, Joint consultancy and Project implementation and any other activities as agreed upon by both the parties.
2. **Modalities of MoU:**
  - a) To take up initiatives for exchange of information relating to activities in teaching and research of mutual interest.
  - b) Post graduate and Doctoral research projects/works to be carried in the AdtU campus and the colleges (wherever adequate laboratory facilities are available) as per the requirements and approved plan of work.
  - c) AdtU would recognize college teachers and research scholars working in different colleges for pursuing doctoral degree as per relevant Ph.D. rules and regulations of AdtU.
  - d) AdtU will consider certain laboratories of college based on the required facilities for conducting doctoral research and recognize faculty members as research supervisor subject to fulfilling the Ph. D. Supervisorship as per AdtU norm.
  - e) Both the parties will provide the field, laboratory and other facilities for undergraduate, Post Graduate and Ph.D. scholars to carry out mutually agreed research program.
  - f) Research finding as result of this collaborative work of both the parties could be jointly published in the public interest.
  - g) AdtU will offer freship/scholarship to poor meritorious students for higher education on recommendation from the college authority and also as per admission guidelines of AdtU.
3. **Faculty exchange programme:** For smooth running of academic programme of different natures, faculty/student exchange programme shall be taken up through mutual experience in teaching and research during the semester period. Honorarium, transportation and accommodation/hospitality as per respective institution norms.
4. **Organization of Seminars/symposia/workshop/training programme:** To organize short term training programme/internship on certain topic of mutual interest; to organize seminar/conference/workshop of national and regional interest. These will bring academic exposure for faculty members and students of both parties.
5. **Collaboration on outreach event:** To have joint collaborative programme to accelerate entrepreneurship, innovation and to conduct outreach activities for the benefit of the society.
6. **Submission of collaborative projects:** Based on the interest and expertise, AdtU faculty members will collaborate with eligible faculty members of college in a specific domain of research and submit project proposal to funding agency and vice-versa. In all such cases, faculty members of both institutes follow the guide lines of funding agencies and rules of respective parent institute.
7. **Study tour programme:** To jointly organize study tour programme in location specific area and interest.
8. **Co Curricular activities (Sports, culture, debate, quiz etc.):** To jointly conduct some Inter-University/college events, nature's camp, field trip, sports cultural programme having common interest.



## 9. Role and Responsibilities:

- a) Both the parties will nominate/designate one nodal officer (not below the rank of Assistant Professor) from respective institutions for smooth conduct of the programme and facilitate implementation of any/or all agreement arising out of this MoU .
- b) To take up collaborative research work based on location specific problem on project mode on mutual agreement hereafter with appropriate funding by respective parties including externally funded projects.
- c) Neither parties shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency beyond control of both parties.
- d) There will be no financial obligations on both the parties under this MoU.

## 10. Duration of MoU, Amendment and Termination:

- a) The agreement shall be effective for a period of Three Years from the date of signing of MoU. The MoU may be modified, renewed or extended with mutual written consent of the parties. The modifications/ changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
- b) The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the mutually agreed upon period.

- d) In the event of termination of the agreement, the rights and obligations of the parties shall be settled by mutual discussion.

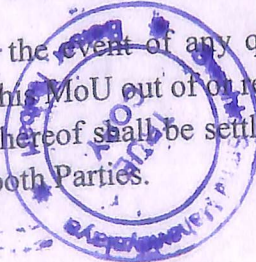
## 11. Sharing of the Facilities:

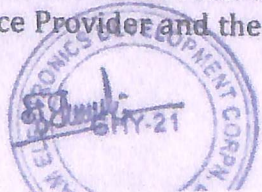

## Where as

1. The Technology Service Provider is a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, I of 1956 and is engaged in the business of providing Education Support services for Educational HEIs and Universities.
  2. The HEI is a UGC approved HEI that has endeavoured to launch programmes that will create employable manpower, which is of crucial importance to the economy of the state and the country.
  3. The HEI is committed to make learning more effective by application of new technology and innovations.. Further the HEI is committed to provide a wide range of professional and vocational Programs to meet the changing socio-economic needs, with human values and purposeful social responsibility.
  4. The Technology Service Provider shall provide its services for all Programs offered by the HEI subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter recorded and agreed to between the parties.
- The Program Manager shall provide program management for all Programs offered by the HEI subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter recorded and agreed to between the parties.

NOW THEREFORE, IN VIEW OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES AND CONSIDERATION SET OUT HEREIN, the Technology Service Provider and the HEI (each individually a "Party"

hereto and collectively the "Parties") have agreed to enter into this Services Agreement ("Agreement") to govern the way in which the Technology Service Provider will provide Academic Support Services to all DA Programs offered by the HEI.

## Scope of Agreement

### 1.1 Scope

This Agreement shall govern the provision of the Employability & Upskilling Services (Apprenticeship/Internship/Trainee/Employee) henceforth known as 'Special Services' to Students who are admitted in existing Programs or new Degree Apprenticeship (DA) Programs (Degree, Diploma, Certificate Programs) by the HEI as per the Program Schedule. The Primary Service will include Special Services delivered to the student on behalf of the HEI by the Technology Service Provider & the Program Manager will handle the program management.

The Special Services will be provided to the HEI students in 2 Formats

- **Format A - Special Services for the Final Year Students**
- **Format B - Launch of new Degree Apprenticeship (DA) Programs with Special Services**

The responsibilities of each party are mentioned in **Annexure A**. The complete list of Programs intended to be covered by this Agreement is provided in **Annexure B** to this Agreement. The afore-mentioned list may be modified by mutual consent at any stage as may be required therein. The fees sharing arrangement between the parties is covered in **Annexure C**. The refund policy is covered in **Annexure D** to this agreement.

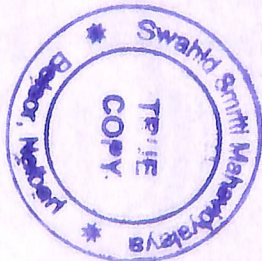
### 1.2 Commencement and Duration of this Agreement

This Agreement shall come into effect on the Effective Date and shall continue till the completion of an initial period of Five years. The Agreement may be renewed with written consent of both the parties for a further period unless either of the parties decides otherwise. In case, any one of the parties decides not to continue or renew the Agreement, the party shall be required to give a written notice to the other party of at least 90 days prior to the expiration of this Agreement.

### 1.3 Approvals and Required Consents

## Breach & Rectification

In the event that either Party believes that the other is in material breach of its obligations under this Agreement, such aggrieved Party may

- i. Serve a Sixty (60) days' notice for curing this material breach. Any notice served pursuant to this Article shall give reasonable details of the Material Breach.
- ii. If the Material Breach is not rectified within this period of 60 days, the aggrieved Party will have the option to terminate the Agreement immediately.

### 1.4 Effect of Termination

On the termination of this Agreement as per the effective date aforesaid, the HEI shall stop the use of the Special Services & the Content and shall return the same to the Technology Service Provider forthwith, along with all documentation copies related to the Service. The Technology Service Provider will continue to service all enrolled students and the HEI will provide necessary support such as conducting exams and the issuing of certificates until the successful completion of the Programs they are admitted for as per the agreed-upon terms and conditions as provided therein. The Fee sharing for these set of students shall continue for this remaining extended period as per the Annexure C.

### 1.5 Dispute Resolution

This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties to this Agreement out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this Agreement or the validity of the breach thereof, which cannot be resolved through mutual discussions, shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by mutual consent of both the parties herein. In the event the Parties are unable to agree on who the sole arbitrator will be, the dispute shall be finally settled by a sole arbitrator, appointed pursuant to Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 will be applicable and the award made thereunder shall be final and binding upon the parties hereto, subject to legal remedies available under the law. Such differences shall be deemed to be a submission to arbitration under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or of any modifications, Rules or re-enactments thereof. The Arbitration proceedings will be held at Guwahati, Assam. Each Party shall bear their own costs and expenses, incurred in connection with the arbitration proceedings.

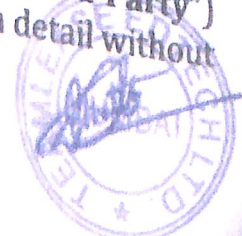
### Indemnification

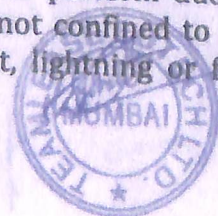
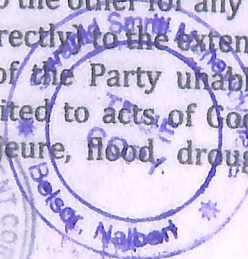
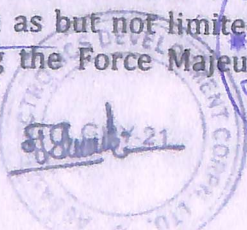
### 1.7 Limitation of Liability



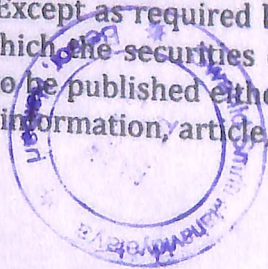
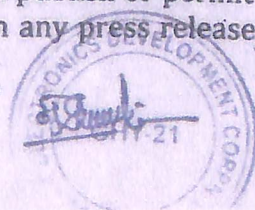
